

Lorrie Reynolds Seminar April 25-26, 2026

Lorrie Reynolds has been involved in dog agility since 2002 and began teaching in 2005, weekly obedience, tricks, and agility classes, as well as weekend agility seminars. Over the years, Lorrie and her dogs have competed in the NADAC and/or DOCNA Championships fifteen times, earning top-three placements in most of those appearances.

She founded Maximum Fun Dog Sports to help handlers build clear communication, confidence, and connection with their dogs so teams can truly have fun on course in any venue. Lorrie believes both dogs *and* people learn best with positive reinforcement, and that training should be an enjoyable experience for both halves of the team.

Because she isn't able to run full courses, Lorrie has focused on teaching her dogs to work confidently and independently at a distance. That perspective has helped many handlers develop stronger communication skills and more confident, capable dogs who can work away.

Lorrie holds a bachelor's degree in psychology, and her corporate career has given her extensive experience in instructional design and adult learning. She combines those skills with practical agility experience to help teams understand not just *what* to train, but *why* it works.

To reach teams beyond in-person classes, Lorrie wrote *Agility FUNDamentals for Distance*, a guide to the core skills teams need to work successfully apart from each other. She is currently training her newest agility partner, an ultra-enthusiastic Australian Koolie who will soon be entering the trial ring.
